



Sessional Representative Nomination Biography for Michael Brisbois

Michael J Brisbois has been working as sessional since 2003 and taught at MacEwan since 2010. As a member of the English department, Michael teaches core first year classes and has designed online courses for MacEwan, normally teaching eight courses a year. He served as sessional representative to the Grant MacEwan University Faculty Association, and as well as a representative in the Department of English. His scholarship has focused on Modernist poetry, apocalyptic thought, and the writings of J. R. R. Tolkien.
